Introduction

You want to produce accurate documents quickly. InfraWare provides a powerful transcription platform to help unleash your full potential by leveraging every keystroke and removing time-consuming barriers to great productivity.

InfraWare Transcription Client (ITC)

The InfraWare Transcription Client (ITC) is a Windows program used by MTs and QA Reviewers to produce and edit documents. The software can be installed either from CD or from a download file available on the Software tab in the InfraWare Management Console (IMC) available via the Web. A valid username, password and license key are required to complete the installation and login. These can be provided by your administrator.

After dictations are created, they are queued in strategic order by the InfraWare Processing Center (IPC). The MT uses the ITC to retrieve jobs from the queue at the processing center. Upon download, the MT gets a job package, including:

The audio dictation First Draft speech recognition text results Normals for the physician/author Document Template Patient demographic data

Once a job is downloaded, productivity tools in the ITC include the following features:

Useful speech recognition results thru synchronous playback of audio/text Keystroke access to normals Built-in word expander Automatic population of patient demographic data to template Access to helpful reminder document specifications

Upon completion of the narrative, a single click by the MT returns the job to the processing center where it is queued for its next workflow step, which might include QA, eSign-off or document delivery.

Additional automation features at the processing center can save the MT's time. For example, when documents must be delivered in batches, the IPC can assemble those batches automatically.

Following transcription, the ITC can be used by transcription managers to review documents in the quality assurance (QA) workflow step.

Getting Started

Before you begin	Please obtain your username (which should be an email address) and a current password from your administrative. Also, please make sure you have the ITC installed before starting. Contact your Administrator if you need help with installation.	
Step-by-step Tutorial	🗹 Task	Login to the ITC as a sample with the username and password obtained from your Supervisor.
	Steps →	 Double-click on the InfraWare Transcription Client (ITC) desktop icon. Enter your entire email address and password as provided. Click Login.
	Notice ≽	Notice that the program loads to the Main Window. This is where you will download dictations and First Drafts to begin the process of turning dictations into transcribed documents that will become a permanent part of the Patients' Medical Record. From this screen, you will be able to begin the process of Editing Dictations as well as a host of other options. These are explored in more detail in the Training Tutorials.
